

CHAMPION POINTS: Points will stay with dog. If you run your dog twice only one placement will be awarded per field. When your dog becomes a BHU amateur champion (AC) it must move into the open class; however the dog can still run in the Amateur Nationals. 5 points for first, 3 points for second, 1 point for third. Trial must have at least 5 dogs in amateur pointing and flushing, 8 in open flushing, 10 in open pointing, and 2 teams in doubles to receive points towards Nationals and placement tags. (Only first place dogs receive tags in doubles class).

HIGH HONOR (HH) POINTS: One point will be awarded for each dog beat in a trial. Dogs run twice only receive HH points for highest placement. Top ten dogs with the highest HH points, four runs at BHU trials throughout year, and a placement in the current year, will have a three bird, one run, trial at nationals to award HH dog of the year. (NATIONALS is the last trial to receive HH points)

NATIONALS QUALIFICATION: **FOUR runs must be ran throughout the current trial season in the OPEN, AMATEUR, and PBR divisions. DOUBLES must have 2 runs in the current trial season to be qualified for NATIONALS. YOUTH must have 3 runs in with the SAME dog. Nationals entries is limited to the top 40 dogs in the HH stakes.**
